Scripture Lesson

Psalm 2:1-12

1:1 Why do the nations rage, and the people plot a vain thing?

1:2 The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD and against His Anointed, saying,

1:3 "Let us break Their bonds in pieces and cast away Their cords from us."

1:4 He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; the LORD shall hold them in derision.

1:5 Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, and distress them in His deep displeasure:

1:6 "Yet I have set My King on My holy hill of Zion."

1:7 "I will declare the decree: the LORD has said to Me, 'You are My Son, today I have begotten You.

1:8 Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession.

1:9 You shall break them with a rod of iron; you shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel."

1:10 Now therefore, be wise, O kings; be instructed, you judges of the earth.

1:11 Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.

1:12 Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and you perish in the way, when His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.
